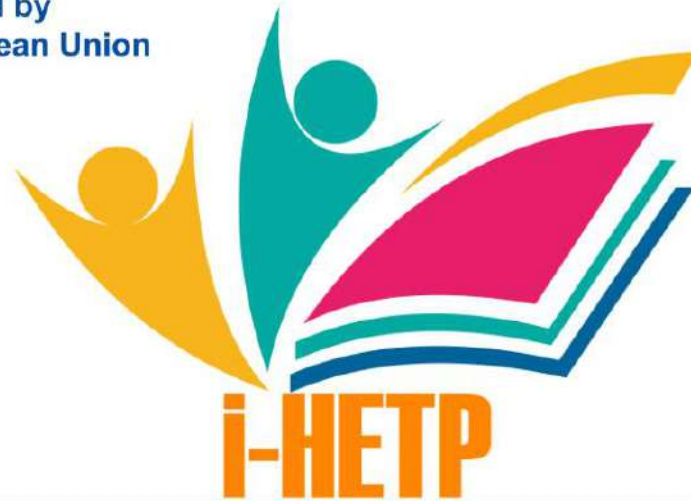

The main objective of the project is to develop and deliver a training program on inclusive teaching methodologies that will prepare higher education teachers to instruct students with disabilities, while improving their overall teaching qualifications, but will do so in an inclusive context, also preparing teachers to teach inclusive classes and produce adapted and accessible teaching materials.

The target groups of the project are higher education professors, but also, indirectly, higher education students and applicants who will benefit from being taught by professors who have pedagogic training and feel ready and confident to instruct students with disabilities. Also the higher education institutions need professors to become ready to instruct students with disabilities.
